

1. The Competition

The Journey through the UK photo competition is organised by the British High Commission in Brunei Darussalam as part of the Education is GREAT campaign. This campaign promotes UK education through a photo competition: 'Journey through the UK' and is sponsored by Royal Brunei Airlines and Laksamana College of Business.

2. Territory and eligibility

The Competition is open to all Bruneian students studying in universities and colleges in the United Kingdom. Only one entry per participant is allowed. Competition entry is free of charge.

3. Competition dates

The opening date of the Competition is Tuesday 27 November 2018 and the closing date is 11.00am (UK time) on Friday 25 January 2019. Any entry received before the opening date or after the closing date will not be included in the Competition.

Each high resolution photograph (can be taken with a smartphone) must be accompanied with a description which cannot exceed 150 words. The description must highlight the impact that your education has had on you as a Bruneian student studying in the UK and how it has shaped your life so far.

The competition will be promoted and marketed by the Brunei Student Union in the UK. For more details please visit the website www.facebook.com/UKinBrunei.

By entering the competition, the candidate agrees that their photographs are their own original work. The participants of the competition are responsible for gaining the consent from people shown in their photographs.

5. Selection of winners and prizes

The British High Commission would like to see photographs about experiences, inspirations and what kind of impact studying in the UK has had on the participants.

There will be two winning photos in total. The two winners will be those two entries which, in the opinion of the judges, best meet the judging criteria that are based on submitting a photo which highlights the participant's journey through the UK and reflects the positive impact UK Education had/will have on shaping their future.

Entries will be judged based on content, quality and the 150 word description. The judges will give merit to those that relate to the theme above. The first prize winner will receive an iPad sponsored by Laksamana College of Business. The second prize winner will receive a discounted UK-Brunei return flight sponsored by Royal Brunei Airlines.

There will also be additional nine consolation prizes that will be given out. The British High Commission reserves the right to invite the winners to talk about their 'Journey through the UK' experience and to receive their prints at the prize presentation which may take place in London mid-February 2019.

The competition winners will be announced during the first week of February 2019. The winners will be contacted by email. The email will include the next

steps required to enable the British High Commission to provide the winner with the prize.

Winning photos will be posted on the British High Commission Facebook page. Details of winners and their entries will be posted on the British High Commission website, Twitter and Facebook pages from Thursday 24 February 2019.

6. Personal data

The British High Commission will collect and store the names and contact details of all winners as anticipated by section 4 above. The British High Commission will use this personal data for the following purposes:

- Managing the relationship between the winners and the British High Commission
- Communicating with winners and arranging delivery of their prizes
- Marketing and publicity in accordance with section 7 below.

By participating in the competition, participants consent to their personal data being processed by the British High Commission in accordance with, and for the purposes set out in section 6.

7. Publicity and rights

The British High Commission in Brunei Darussalam and partner sponsors intend to publish the names and photographs of the winners on the British High Commission website, Facebook pages, Twitter pages, press releases and in other promotional and marketing material.

In addition, the British High Commission in Brunei Darussalam may write and publish material about the winners' receiving prizes. By entering the competition, each participant agrees to the use of their name and image and agrees to co-operate with any publicity or marketing if they win a prize.

Participants will retain copyright in the entry material that they submit to the British High Commission in Brunei Darussalam.

By entering the competition each participant grants the British High Commission and sponsors, free of charge, permission to use the entry material (without limitation, modifying and adapting it for operational and editorial reasons) in any media worldwide for purposes connected with the Education is GREAT campaign and program or either sponsor organisation.

Participants who win a prize grant the British High Commission in Brunei Darussalam and sponsors further permission to publish and exhibit their entry material (without limitation, modifying and adapting it for operational and editorial reasons) in print and any media worldwide for any British High Commission and/or sponsor purpose.

Each participant confirms that the entry material is their own original work, is not defamatory, does not infringe any English laws and that they give the British High Commission permission to use it for the purposes specified above, and that all necessary consents for the submission of the entry material have been obtained.
